NOTICE

This is for information of all concerned that addressing the needs of the industry and society, MAKAUT has created a unique mechanism of awarding 100 Activity points over the academic grade. As per Mandatory Additional Requirement for earning B.Tech degree as notified by MAKAUT in its various Notices, the latest one dated 24/04/2018, all the registered students of B.Tech from 2018-19 have to earn following points on various co-curricular and extra-curricular activities apart from their compulsory and regular courses:

1 st year (admitted in 2018-19)	100 points
2 nd year (admitted in 2017-18)	100 points
3 rd year (admitted in 2016-17)	75 points
4 th year (admitted in 2015-16)	50 points

MAKAUT has also provided a list of 30 Activity Heads along with the capping of the Activity points that can be earned by a student during the entire B.Tech duration.

In every semester, every student is required to prepare a file containing documentary proof of activities, done by him/her. This file will be verified and Activity Points will be assigned by the concerned teacher, i.e. **MENTOR**, at the end of every semester. Points secured by the students have to be sent to Controller of Examinations, MAKAUT, after the completion of theory papers and before the publication of semester result. **A student's result of his/her final examination will be withheld until he/she completes the minimum activity points.**

Considering the thrust of MAKAUT to make the students technologically sound and **also well-prepared to meet the industry requirement, these activities are extremely important for a B.Tech student.** It may be noted that MOOCS (SWAYAM/NPTEL/Spoken Tutorial (per course) is the most prominent activity through which a student can earn minimum 20 points and maximum 40 points.

Keeping the mandate of MAKAUT in mind, a committee is hereby constituted **to look after the MOOCS and all consolidated Activity Points related areas, effective forthwith.**

Prof. (Dr.) N. N. Pathak, HOD (ECE), Prof. (Dr.) C. Koner, HOD (CSE) and Prof. S. Maity, HOD (IT) will act as **ADVISORS** in the committee. **Prof. (Dr.) Tribeni Prasad Banerjee** of ECE department will act as Chief Coordinator and **SPOC** for both **NPTEL** and **Spoken Tutorial Project-IIT (Bombay)**.
